Maths activities

- Work on Numbots. Your child will have an individual login to access this. Details are stuck into the front of your child's homework book.
- Sing some counting songs with Jack Hartmann

- Practise counting in 1s starting on any number.
- Start on any number and count back to 0.
- Play on 'Hit the button' focus on number bonds to 10 and then number bonds to 20. www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button
- Write numbers 1-20
- Find pairs of numbers to make 10. Use pasta as counters!
- Play 'Robot More or less' Choose 'up to 10.' www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/robot-more-or-less
- Find different 2D and 3D shapes around the house. (Square, circle, triangle, rectangle, hexagon, cube, cuboid, cylinder, sphere, pyramid)

Reading and Phonics activities

- Read to your child every day. Children can choose a book from the book corner as often as they wish.
- Listen to your child read their Collins Big Cat book and let them talk about what they have read. Please read this book at least 3 times a week. **(Please remember to bring your Collins Big Cat book back to school every THURSDAY so I can change it for you and give you a new one on Friday.)**
- Play some of the free phonics games on www.phonicsplay.co.uk
- some phonics games on 'Teach your monster to read.' You have to sign up for this but it is free. www.teachyourmonster.org

Writing activities

- Practise writing your name correctly. When you can write your first name, try writing your surname too.
- Practise forming your letters correctly. Use the Little Wandle rhymes to help you. The Reception Autumn 1 and Autumn 2 documents explain how to form the letters correctly. www.littlewandlelettersandsounds.org.uk/resources/for-parents/
- Look inside the cover of your Collins Big Cat books. There are some words for you to read. When you have read them, try writing them too.
- Do you remember writing a letter to the Aliens about what we do at Thameside? Write them a letter telling them all the different things you do at home.

Wider curriculum ideas to try!

Let's Wonder:

- How is the world around us changing now that Autumn is here? Go for an autumn walk and talk about all the things you can see. Look at the leaves – how many different colours can you see? Go for the same walk at the end of term. What differences do you notice?

Let's Create:
