## Swimming statement

Under normal circumstances, children in Year 3, 4 and 5 swim for 12 weeks each year. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, no swimming lessons took place from March 2020 until May 2021. The Year 4 children went swimming in the Summer Term of 2021.

For 2021-2022 swimming lessons will take place as follows (Covid permitting): Year 5/6 in the Autumn Term of 2021; Year 4/5 in the Spring Term of 2022 and Year 3 in the Summer Term of 2022. All of KS2 are taking part in swimming lessons to address the missed lesson due to Covid restrictions.
