English – furious, enchanted, contented, inquisitive, monstrous, penniless Maths – place value, half, quarter, multiply, divide, equal Computing – database, data, group, label, identify, compare Science – reptile, scales, mammal, fins, gills, amphibian Art – portrait, sketch, technique, sculpture, artist, create RE – Judaism, Sabbath, Shabbat, Kippah, Synagogue, Ceremony Geography – forest, desert, city, location, coast, Great Britain

Key Vocabulary



In English we will be reading 'Jack and the Beanstalk' illustrated by Giuseppe Di Lernia. We will be writing our own stories based on this.

We will consolidate our understanding and use of punctuation and will use adjectives to make our writing more interesting.

We will also be reading non-fiction texts and writing questions and answers linked to our learning in Geography.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be learning about:

- Number -Place value and numbers to 100, counting in 10s, comparing and ordering numbers.
- Calculations Multiplication and division counting in 2,
 5, and 10. Making and counting equal groups.
- Fractions halves and quarters
- Money recognising and counting coins and notes.
- Geometry-position and direction
- Time months of the year, days of the week, hours, minutes, seconds, telling the time (on the hour, half past).

Science

In science we will be learning about animals that live in Madagascar. We will look at the different types of food these animals eat. We will also compare rainforest animals to native British woodland animals.

Computing

In Computing, we are learning about Databases and grouping data. This will involve labelling objects, identifying objects that can be counted, comparing groups of objects and answering questions about groups of objects.

RE

In RE we will be considering the question, 'Is Shabbat important for Jewish children?' We will be learning about Judaism and what Jewish children do on the Sabbath as well as learning about the Shabbat meal.

PE

In PE we will developing football skills. We will learn to control the ball with our feet and to pass the ball to another player. We will also be learning net and wall skills.

Learning to Learn

Our Learning to Learn focus this term is 'Imagination.' We will be reading 'Use your imagination' by Nicola O'Byrne and thinking about how our imagination can make us better learners.

Geography

In Geography, we will be naming the 7 continents, and will learn about the human and physical geography in several non-European countries. We will also be using maps, atlases and globes.

Art

In Art, we will be learning about self-portraits. We will look at famous artists and then use sketching, painting and clay to create our own self-portraits.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about feelings. We will talk about different types of feeling and how to manage them. We will also talk about change and loss and how this can feel.

Music

In Music our themes are 'Storytime' and 'Our bodies.' We will be using percussion instruments to explore sound and will also be looking at the beat in music.
