

Key Vocabulary

English

In English, we will be building on our D&T food work from last term by writing to persuade pupils and their families to eat healthily. Our leaflets and posters will be displayed in the office entrance and dining hall. In reading, we will be enjoying another amazing novel from former children's laureate, Michael Morpurgo, called 'The Puffin Keeper'. This, and other shorter books we'll be reading over the term, all have a coastal theme to tie in with our learning in Geography.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be finishing off the unit on measuring length and perimeter in millimetres, centimetres and metres. After this, we will move on to a unit on fractions. In Year 2, we learnt about halves, quarters and thirds. The next step is to look at fractions with other denominators, such as fifths. This is a great skill to practise at home, for example dividing up pizzas or cakes into equal pieces.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about how rocks tell us about the past. We will look at different types of rocks and how they were created, linking to our Term 2 writing on Mary Anning!

Computing

In Computing, we will be exploring data information, specifically branching databases and how they are used in the real world. We will create our own databases to identify different types of dinosaurs.

Religious Education

For the rest of the year, we will be learning about Hinduism and what is special to people who follow this religion. We'll be starting by learning about Brahman.

PE

In PE this term, we will be revisiting Cricket. The children have worked on catching/bowling, so now we will focus on batting. In gymnastics, we will again build on prior knowledge of travelling and balancing to create floor routines.

Spanish

In Spanish, we are continuing the theme of food and healthy eating as we learn vocabulary for different sorts of fruit and vegetables. We will also be revising our numbers, counting up and down.

Geography

In Geography, we'll be learning all about the UK's coastlines, finishing off with a presentation on a seaside location that the pupils will choose themselves. We will look at both the physical and human aspects of those places.

Art

In Art, we will focus on famous buildings and the work of Sir Christopher Wren. We will look at symmetrical artwork, practising our tracing. We will also learn completely new techniques like hatching, stippling and scumbling!

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be starting a new unit looking at money. We will be talking about financial wellbeing – spending, budgeting and saving.

Music

In Music, we will be building on Science knowledge from Term 4 with our 'Human Body' unit. Towards half term, we will also be trying out some songs in French!

Learning to Learn

Our new Learning to Learn focus is Imagination. We'll be developing this through visualisation in our reading lessons as well as enjoying loads of lovely end-of-day texts with imaginative settings.
