




Key Vocabulary



English

In English we will be reading 'The Kiss that Missed' by David Melling. We will be using this text to help us write sentences about what dragons do.

We will also be reading non-fiction texts about castles and will be writing factual sentences about them.

We will be continuing to work on holding the pencil correctly and forming the letters well, starting in the right place.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be learning about:

- Addition and Subtraction – part and whole model, writing number sentences, fact families, number bonds to 10.
- Shape - recognise, name and sort 2D and 3D shapes, Make patterns with 2D and 3D shapes
- Problem solving linked to all areas of Maths.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about 'Energy: Light and Seasons.' We will be thinking about objects that make light and how we need light to see. We will also be learning how animals have different senses that are adapted to their needs.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about digital painting. We will use a range of tools for digital painting. Children will then use these tools to create their own digital painting.

RE

In RE, we will be learning about the Christian Christmas Story. During the term we will think about answering the question, "What gifts might my town have given to Jesus if he had been born here rather than in Bethlehem?"

PE

Our PE this term will be Tag Rugby on Wednesdays and Dance on Fridays. We'll be looking at line, angles and shapes in Dance. We will be practising throwing and catching, tagging and passing backwards in Tag Rugby.

Learning to Learn

This term, we will continue to think about 'Perseverance.' As our Maths and Spelling gets a bit trickier, we will talk about good strategies to use when the work is hard.

History

In History, we will be learning about castles. We will be learning the names of different parts of a castle, why castles were built and what life was like in a castle.

DT

In DT, we will be making hand puppets. We will design our hand puppets, cut felt hands and join them using different methods. We will then decorate them to look like characters from a story.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be thinking about keeping safe. We will learn about real and imaginary dangers, keeping ourselves safe and who to talk to when we don't feel safe.

Music

In Music, our themes are 'Animals' and 'Weather.' We will be exploring pitch and making sounds using our bodies and percussion instruments.
